Sponsorship Levels:

Sponsorship and recruiting opportunities are limited in quantity for better brand exposure and easier candidate engagement.

Premier Sponsor (\$20,000) (Limit 1): Supports employer and job candidate outreach, recruitment, communication, and technology resources to ensure a smooth "best in class" virtual career fair experience that connects disability inclusive employers to qualified job candidates with disabilities.
